
- Improved Numeracy outcomes as evidenced in NAPLAN results.
- Improved Writing outcomes as evidenced in NAPLAN results.
- Increased levels of higher order thinking and oral language development.

**Our initiatives include**

- Strategy 1: collaborative teacher investigations into gaps in understanding and processes for student problem solving in Numeracy.
- Strategy 2: coaching of teachers in Higher Order thinking and Oral Language development through the Inquiry Learning project approach.
- Strategy 3: Writing – coaching of teachers using rubrics to set goals and supporting target lessons and individual conferencing to move students forward in goals.

**Our school will improve student outcomes by**

1. Release teachers for one hour a week to participate in “Strategic Inquiry” processes. These include team meetings to review and collaboratively plan for incremental improvements for students who are case studies from both struggling and talented groups. On alternate weeks, teachers will be engaged in peer observation and feedback processes related to the plans made in the SI meetings. In 2015 the focus will be on Maths – in particular problem solving. Teacher collaboration, peer observation, feedback and reflection is one of the highest of Hattie’s strategies for high effect size	\$40,000
2. Resource the additional time for a school based Master Teacher. The Master Teacher will be involved in coaching teachers in processes for Inquiry Based Learning with a focus on Oral Language Development and Higher Order Thinking and improving writing through coaching in the use of Rubrics and Goal Setting with Target Lessons. Inquiry Based Learning has a very high Effective Size of 1.14 and Hypothetical Thinking of .65. Higher Order thinking effect size of 1.16 and higher order questioning of .46.	\$54,258
